I have recently started at Framlingham College, IP13 9EY as the Health, Safety and Compliance Manager.

At present there is a Zebra Crossing situated on College Road, linking the main College and 3 x Boarding Houses

The 3 x Boarding Houses, is residential accommodation for approximately 225 students, including International and wheelchair Students that use the Zebra Crossing at least 8 times per day, including weekends.

There are issues with the Zebra Crossing that require immediate action:

Insufficient Lighting

No Speed warning signage.

thank you for your email regarding the Zebra crossing. Framlingham Town Council is not responsible for the issues, as that lies with the County Council Highways department. However, I note your concerns and will take some photographs at night (if you have any that illustrate the issue that would also help) and report these to the Highways Department. It greatly helps if you could also raise these concerns directly with them. Unfortunately, the only way to do this is via the 'Highways reporting tool' (we have to use it as well) - the link is here: <https://highwaysreporting.suffolk.gov.uk/>.

I will place this before the Town Council's Highways Committee and I would hope they will authorise me to give you further support to resolve these difficulties. I am afraid that this sort of thing usually ends up as a longer campaign than one would wish for, but I would hope that the Town Council would support you, and it will work with you to resolve the issue.
