

Pembroke Road Junction with B1119 – Mount Pleasant/Saxtead Road Safety Improvements

Following the Neighbourhood Plan in 2017, investigations on pedestrian routes into and out of Framlingham town centre identified the Mount Pleasant/Pembroke Road junction as being in particular need of change to improve pedestrian safety.

Suffolk County Council have now advised that they plan to carry out this work early in 2023. Please see before and after sketches below.

Essentially the entrance to Pembroke Road will be narrowed by building out from the north side and then a safety fence will be installed on the south side and drop kerbs to make a crossing place a few yards further away from the main road. Vehicles coming into Pembroke Road from the Saxtead direction will be obliged to slow more than is currently the custom.
