Selling of Poppy items

This year again we are able to go back to doing House to House collections, However, as we have limited numbers of collectors sadly some areas will not be covered by this service, what we will be doing to counter balance this is to have a stall on the Market Hill and also at the back entrance of the Co-op on Saturday 5th and 12th November 2022 where we will be selling poppy stock, and collecting donations. Minimal handling of goods will be encouraged. This year we have Two contactless machine so we will have one at both Stalls.

The Garden of Remembrance will be sited in-front of the Cenotaph (War Memorial) in the church grounds as normal. Wooden crosses will be in the church foyer along with envelopes for you to place your donations then the envelope is to be put into the church wall safe please.

Remembrance Sunday 13 November 2022

Following discussions with the Town Council and Church in line with guidelines we are able to hold a Remembrance service this year along the old format in brief the event will take place as follows:

Parade and Service:

10.15/20am - Meet in New Road

10.30am - Parade Marshall Eddie Cooper will assemble the parade

10.40am - Parade leaves New Road and marches through the town via Bridge Street, Market Hill, Church Street and into the churchyard

10.50am - Parade assembles in the churchyard around the war memorial

The names are read

After the reading- the wreaths are laid in order of protocol:

Act of Remembrance by Older / Younger person

All affirm: We will remember them.

The Last Post is sounded

11.00am - 2 minutes silence

Reveille is played

All proceed into the Church for the service - Standard Bearers, Town Council, Veterans parading, and youth groups to go in first

After the service the Parade is re-assembled in the Churchyard and marches down to the Market Hill.

Speeches of thanks are given prior too dismissal.

Friday 11th November 2022

11am - 2 Minute Silence will take place by the **cenotaph** in the **church grounds**.

The Framlingham RBL Standard will be present.
